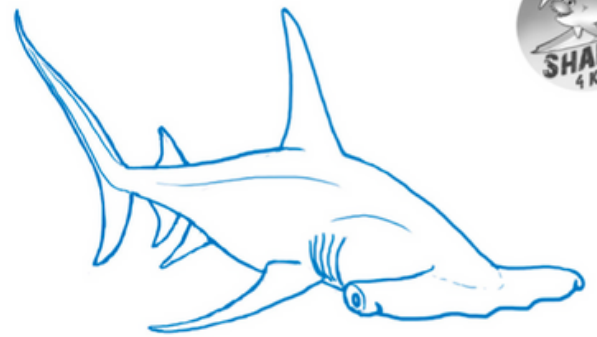


How to draw a great hammerhead shark (*Sphyrna mokarran*)

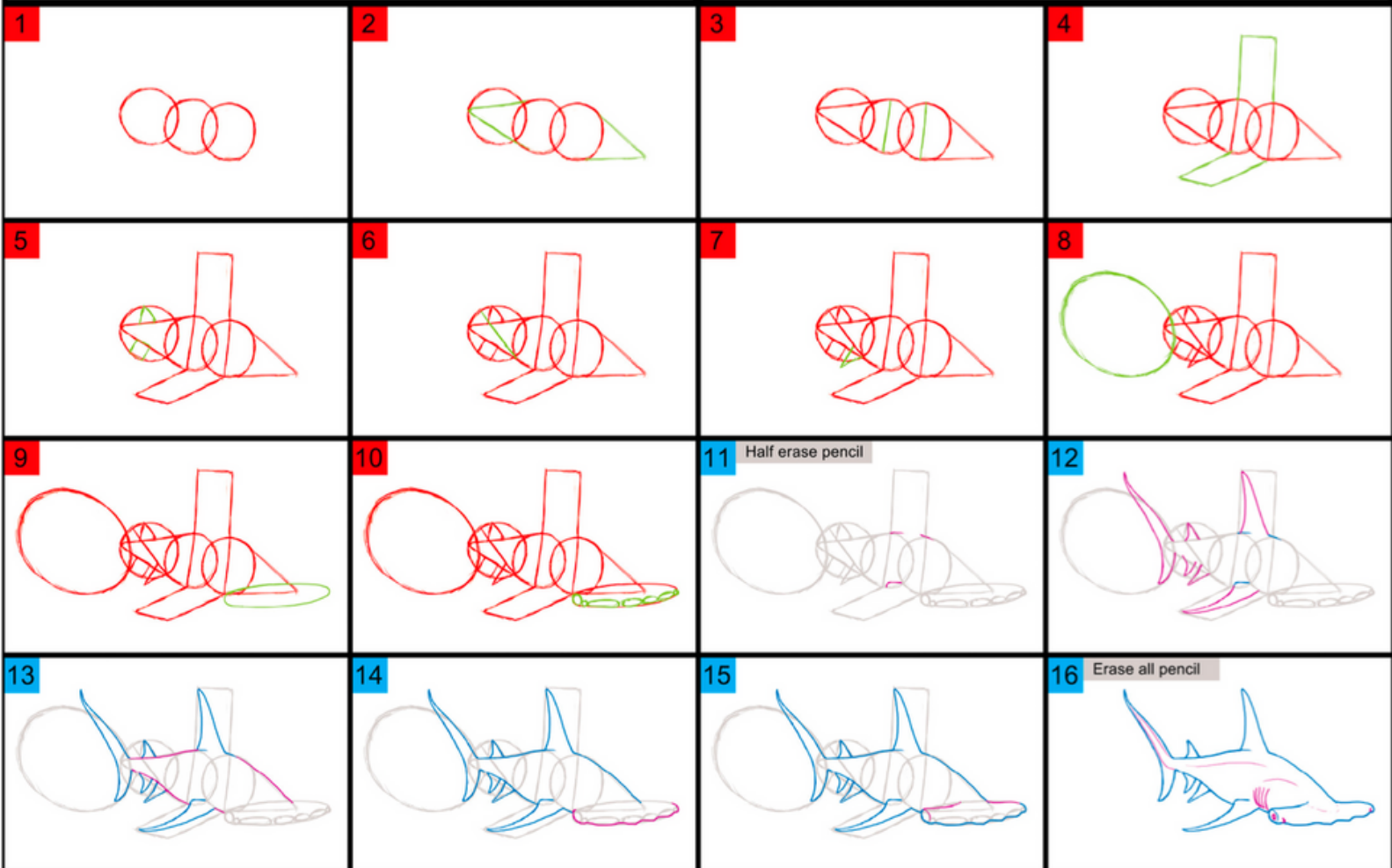

GREAT HAMMERHEADS

The largest of all hammerhead species, growing to 20 feet and weighing over 500 pounds, they use their large heads, or cephalofoil, to stun their prey.
