BEFORE I ARRIVE

WHAT TO BRING

PARKING

The parking lot is very big and has many cars. I need to be sure to walk – not run – to the main entrance of Wonders of Wildlife.

FACILITY LAYOUT


Wonders of Wildlife has 3 separate parts to the tour:

PURCHASING TICKETS





SENSORY ITEMS

WHERE TO START

Once at the top of the escalator, I walk through a long hallway with large pictures, videos, and screens. This is a quiet area if there not many people around.








BASS PRO AND NASCAR MUSEUM

PHOTOS



DISCOVERY THEATER

I will enter the Discovery Theater to watch a short video when the doors are open. If I want to watch the video and the doors are not open, there is a screen to the right of the door that tells me how much longer I need to wait until the next showing.

Inside the theater, it is dark, and the movie can have loud, sudden noises. If I do not want to watch the video, I can keep walking through the hallway to start the Wildlife Galleries tour.

The Wildlife Galleries have different rooms displaying taxidermy and artificial habitats. If I feel overwhelmed by the exhibits, I can calmly walk to the next exhibit, ask a team member for help, or find a place to sit and collect my thoughts.

FLOORING

Some areas of Wonders of Wildlife have different flooring textures. Some floors are rough and unlevel, while others are smooth like glass. I will make sure to watch my step and be aware of changing floors.







CATWALK

At the end of the Wildlife Galleries, there is a large catwalk that is very bright and tall. If I feel nervous walking along this area, I can take the elevator to the main level of the lobby.

AQUARIUM ADVENTURE

The aquarium has animals from all over the world. If I get excited about an animal, I will remain calm and keep my hands to myself. If I get nervous around an animal, I will calmly walk away and know that I am safe.



ESCALATORS AND ELEVATORS

To get through the facility, there are escalators and elevators I might have to take to get to the next exhibit. If I am nervous about these obstacles, I can choose whichever option is easiest for me to use or ask a team member for help.







TAKING PICTURES

I am allowed to use my phone or camera to take photos and videos at Wonders of Wildlife. I will make sure that my flash is turned off so I do not frighten the animals that live here.



BRIGHT EXHIBITS

There are a lot of fun exhibits at Wonders of Wildlife. Some of them are bright, but I can shield my eyes if they're too bright for me.







DARK EXHIBITS


Other exhibits may be dark, but I'll still be able to see well enough to walk around. I can always ask a team member for help if I need it.



TEMPERATURES AND SCENTS

Many rooms in the Wildlife Galleries and Aquarium Adventure have unique scents and temperatures. If I am uncomfortable with the temperature or the scent of a room, I can continue walking to the next area in my tour.







TOUCH POOLS

When I tour the aquarium, I can gently touch animals like horseshoe crabs, stingrays, or small sharks. Team members will show me how to touch safely. If I do not want to touch them, I can just watch them swim. Sometimes the tanks will be closed to give the animals a rest. If they are not open, I can come visit these animals next time.

LEARNING

I can learn a lot at Wonders of Wildlife! I might get to see a team member giving a talk about an exhibit or animal. I can also read the signs or watch the videos to learn more about the animals in each exhibit.







RESTROOMS

There are several restrooms located all around the facility. If I need to use the restroom, I can look for a restroom sign or ask a team member to help me find the closest one.



RESTAURANTS

If I get hungry, I can visit Fish Tales Café in the aquarium Iobby or the Shipwreck Reef Snack Bar in the aquarium. These cost extra money.







THE GIFT SHOP

When I exit the aquarium, I will walk through the gift shop. If I brought money and would like to purchase an item, I can. If not, I can walk through the gift shop to get back to the main lobby.



BASS PRO SHOPS ENTRANCE

I can still access the aquarium if I enter through the main doors of Bass Pro Shops. I can also go shopping in Bass Pro, so I will need to bring money if I want to shop.

If I come in the Bass Pro entrance, I can find this escalator and the big brass deer. This is where I can start my tour of Wonders of Wildlife. If I need help finding my way, I can ask an associate for directions.
